- Four solar-electric systems to be installed at the schools on Lopez, Orcas, San Juan and Shaw Islands.
- No cost to the school districts for the purchase or installation of the solar-electric systems. All of the energy generated will be donated to the school districts, lowering their electricity costs.
- Bonneville Environmental Foundation to provide educational curriculum, teacher training, and science kits for each school to support our schools' science programs.
- San Juan County residents and businesses can purchase solar units at \$200 each, up to 100 solar units per individual (approximately 5 kW).
- Participants to receive annual energy production incentive payments through 2024 that are anticipated to fully pay back participants for the cost of the solar units purchased.
- Participants can also choose to donate their incentive payments to the San Juan County school district of their choice.
